



SOUTHBOURNE WINTER BOWLS PAIRS LEAGUE 2020-21

RULES OF PLAY

1. Entry to this competition is open to all Southbourne Bowls Club members.
2. Substitutes are allowed (not during the course of a match) but are restricted to playing for just one team during the season.
3. Each team will play an equal number of matches 13. No team will play the same team twice. A Fixture sheet will be displayed on the club competition notice board.
4. Each match should be played on the date and time published on the fixture sheet. However it is permissible to play a fixture at any time earlier than the published date or up to one week after the published date if necessary and agreed upon by both teams. Failure to play a match within the above period will result in nil points being awarded to both teams.

An extension to the above period may be granted by the Competition Secretary for unforeseen circumstances only, provided the request is made within the above period.

If a match cannot be played within the above period then the Competition Secretary can rule in favour of a team, provided a request is made within the above period. A successful ruling will result in six points being awarded to the favoured team and one point to the unfavoured team.

5. Matches to be played on the Rinks specified on the Fixture sheet (not be drawn).
6. Matches will be played over sixteen ends with no trial ends. Only one shot will be awarded on the first end. A no-end will not be replayed and will be scored as two shots against the team causing that no-end.
7. A total of ten points is available for each match and will be awarded to the teams based on shot difference, as follows:

Drawn game	5 - 5
Win by 1 to 5 shots	6 - 4
Win by 6 to 10 shots	7 - 3
Win by 11 to 15 shots	8 - 2
Win by 16 to 20 shots	9 - 1
Win by greater than 20 shots	10 - 0

8. The Competition Secretary's decision is final in all disputes.
9. The competition Secretary reserves the right to add to or amend the rules as necessary.

Additional rules for winter 20-21 season

A) Social distancing rules must be strictly adhered to; you must remain at least two metres apart from other bowlers (who are not part of your household) at all times. If you need to enter the changing room or main club for any reason the wearing of face masks IAW national guidelines must be adhered to.

B) Play will be on all rinks **1, 3, 5 starting at 10am and 2, 4, 6 starting at 10-30am** refer to Fixture sheet. To reduce the number of people in the changing room area players are **to arrive no more than twenty minutes** before the start of their game.

C) Mats/jacks must be sanitised before and after each session.

D) Jack to be placed in position and not rolled.

E) Spray marking of toucher bowls only (NO STICKS OF CHALK)

F) Avoid measuring for shot/s wherever possible.

G) Avoid touching of other plays bowls by hand.

F) Any rearranged matches will have to be booked via the Bowls Club rink booking system.
